Our School

The Richmond Chinese School (RCS) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to teaching Chinese language and prompting appreciation of Chinese culture, serving children and adults.

The American culture derives its strength from its ingenuity, resourcefulness, and most importantly, contributions by diverse cultures and communities. It would not be the same if it ever ceases to draw the strength from immigrants.

We recognize the value of a language as the basic tool for seeking knowledge, and the need to preserve the proud Chinese culture and tradition among younger generations.

Our school was founded in 1975 with 20 students. We now have an enrollment of about 100 students. We offer many levels of instruction and varieties of culture classes as well as culture programs for parents. Classes are held on Sundays, 2:00 – 4:00 p.m., September through May. Culture classes are held on the 2nd and 4th Sundays from 4:00 to 5:00 p.m. We also share our resources with local institutions and schools. Mandarin in the traditional

complex system is the language used in the classrooms.

The school is governed by a Board of Directors. The six directors are elected by enrolled adult students and parents of enrolled minor students for a two-year term. The Board represents the families of the School and makes decisions regarding the operation of the School and the appointment of a principal and a vice principal to coordinate the various educational programs.

Our school, like any other voluntary, nonprofit organization, can succeed only with the cooperation of dedicated volunteers who provide their time and services. Fortunately, our school, in its over twenty-six-year history, has been able to count on these dedicated individuals who have served conscientiously to further its advancement. However, as the workload increases and volunteer help is always in short supply, we encourage every family of our school and our Chinese community to volunteer their services.

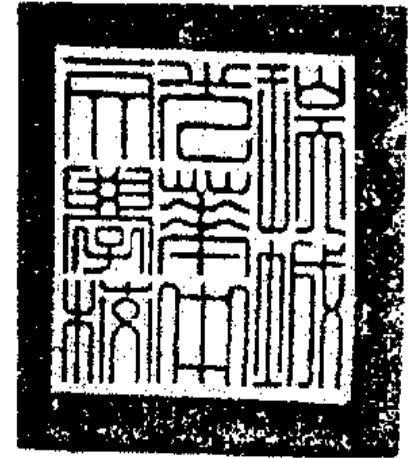
